

Covered Dental Care is MY REASON TO SMILE



A recent survey conducted with **208 Marylanders** found that nearly half of surveyed adults have not seen a dentist in the last two years. With the newly expanded Maryland Healthy Smiles dental benefits, more accessible oral care is possible.

After years of working collectively with partners to advocate the Maryland General Assembly to add dental coverage to Maryland Medicaid, **all adults enrolled in the full Medicaid program now have comprehensive dental benefits through the Maryland Healthy Smiles Dental Program.** The Maryland Dental Action Coalition (MDAC), the state's leading non-governmental oral health policy and advocacy organization, is working to encourage Marylanders who are eligible to receive the newly expanded Maryland Healthy Smiles dental benefits to make dental appointments. MDAC is also encouraging more dentists to see adult patients with Medicaid coverage.

In 2023, MDAC surveyed 208 Marylanders from all across the state to help inform our outreach campaign and learn more about their awareness of dental benefits under Medicaid, their oral health care habits, the importance of seeing a dentist, barriers to getting dental care, and more.

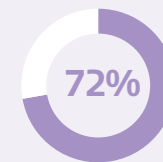
Understanding Marylanders' Oral Health Care Needs



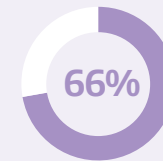
of respondents said they currently **have health insurance** with **86%** having Medicaid/HealthChoice.

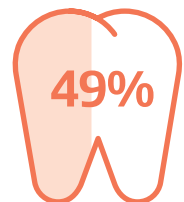
Survey respondents who **have not been to the dentist in the past two years** reported the top two reasons were:

no dental insurance (29%)

not knowing what type of dental care is covered by their insurance (24%)

73% of respondents who have not seen a dentist in the past two years said they were more likely to see a dentist if these issues were removed.

Maryland Needs More Dentists Who Accept Medicaid



are currently in Maryland, but only 29% see patients with Medicaid insurance.*

The lack of dentists seeing adult patients with Medicaid coverage is a large barrier to care, but numbers are improving.

Currently, of the **4,236 active dentists in Maryland...**

1,175 dentists have treated at least one adult Medicaid patient (27%).**

1,680 dentists are credentialed to accept adults with Medicaid (29%).**
